A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF BOISE CITY TO REALIGN THE BOUNDARIES WITHIN THE EXISTING DISTRICT; TO INCREASE THE ASSESSMENTS OF THE DOWNTOWN BOISE ASSOCIATION; SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSAL; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO CAUSE NOTICE THEREOF TO BE PUBLISHED; DIRECTING THE DOWNTOWN BOISE ASSOCIATION TO MAIL A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO BUSINESSES WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS on or about July 7, 1987 by Ordinance Number 5019, the Boise City Council created the Downtown Boise Association, a Business Improvement District authorized by Title 50, Chapter 26, Idaho Code; and,

WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the Downtown Boise Association has recommended to the Boise City Council that it increase the assessments imposed on businesses within its boundaries by more than five per cent (5%).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOISE CITY, IDAHO:

Section 1. That the Council consider amending the assessment schedule for members of the Downtown Boise Association be amended by the addition of a base rate assessment from retail businesses within its boundaries by \$225 per year and office or commercial businesses within its boundaries by \$100 per year.

Section 2. That the Council consider amending the service boundaries within the established Business Improvement District as follows:

- The "8<sup>th</sup> St. Marketplace / Old Boise Areas" will be herein referred to as the "Outer Core Area"
- Outer Core designations will encompass the four areas within bordered by:
  - Bannock - Front - Capitol - 5<sup>th</sup> Streets
  - Capitol - 9<sup>th</sup> - Front - Myrtle Streets
  - Grove - Idaho - 12<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> Streets
  - 8<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> - State - Jefferson Streets

Section 3. That the Council consider amending the definition of Retail Businesses to include businesses which are oriented to public trade or selling a product, including Financial Products (includes restaurants, Barber Shops, Banks, etc.)

Section 4. That the City Clerk schedule a public hearing on the proposal for February 4,

2003 at the hour of 7:30 p.m. in City Hall.

Section 5. That the City Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized to cause to be published notice of this proposal to increase assessments due; together with the date, time and place of the public hearing in at least one (1) newspaper once each week for two (2) weeks preceding the week of February 4, 2003.

Section 6. That the Downtown Boise Association cause a copy of this resolution to be mailed to each of the businesses within the boundaries of the business improvement district not less than ten (10) days before said hearing.

Section 7. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
